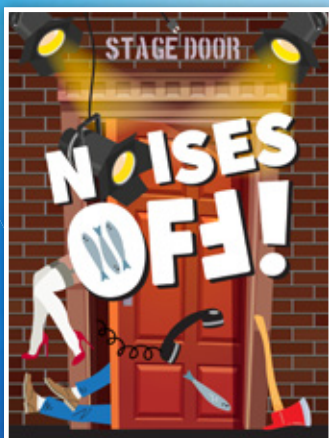

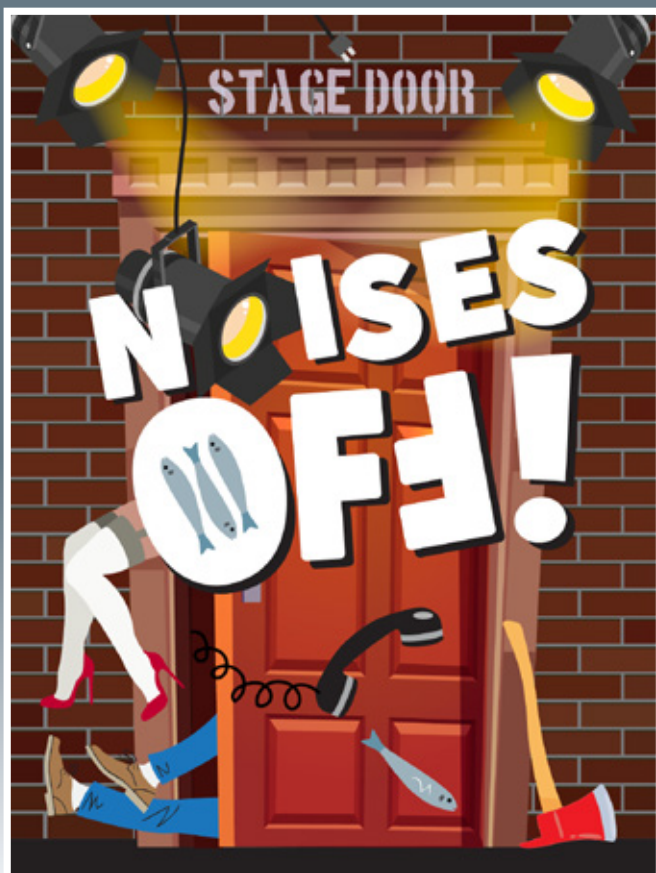
Willy Wonka's world of pure imagination!

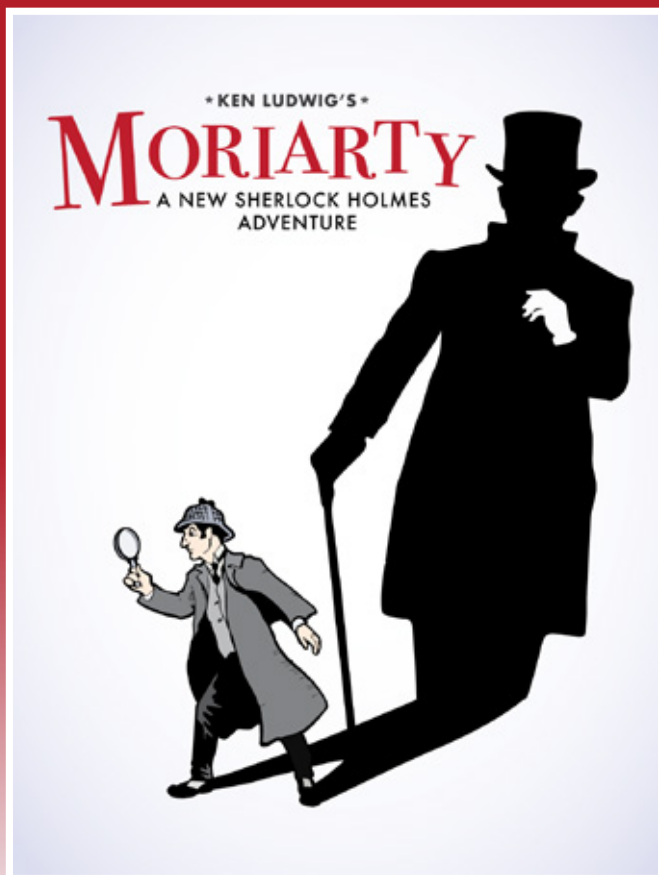
A high-energy, slapstick comedy that exposes the backstage shenanigans of a quirky theatre company.
