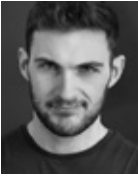


DANIEL HARRAY*

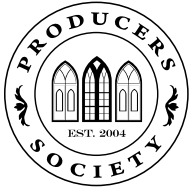
