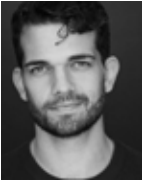


ROZ SPEAR

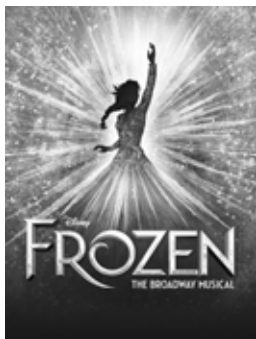
