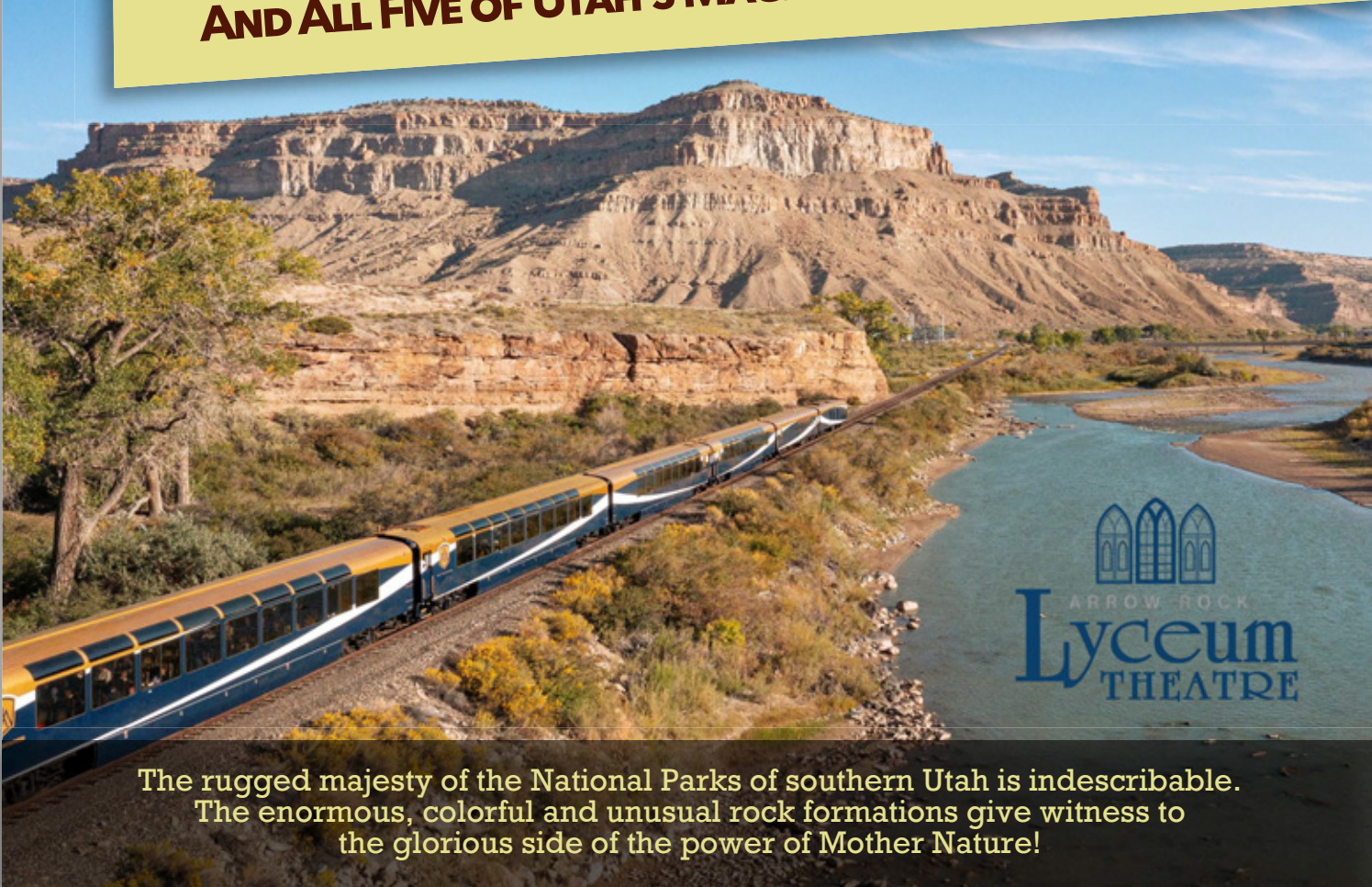

### **MONDAY, OCTOBER 12 (KICKBACK RECEPTION)**

Fly with us to **Denver, Colorado** where we will begin our *Rockies to Red Rocks* adventure! On arrival we will check into the **Drury Plaza Hotel Central Park**. Tonight, enjoy the hotel's **Kickback Reception** with hot food and cold drinks.

### **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 13 (BREAKFAST, LUNCH)**

This morning we transfer to Denver's Union Station to experience the **Rocky Mountaineer's** newest rail journey, **Rockies to Red Rocks** aboard the **Canyon Spirit**! Breakfast and lunch are served on the train. On our all-daylight rail tour we'll witness extraordinary landscapes including vast canyons, natural archways, and enchanting hoodoos. Today we cross the **Continental Divide** while cutting through 6.3 miles of the engineering marvel, the **Moffat Tunnel**. Our afternoon course follows the Colorado River through rugged **Glenwood Canyon** before arriving in **Glenwood Springs**, where we will check into a hotel for one night.

### **WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 14 (BREAKFAST, DINNER)**

It's "all aboard" this morning at the Glenwood Springs train station for our **second day on the Canyon Spirit** as we continue our journey west. Breakfast is served on board. We cross the Colorado-Utah border with stunning mountain views in the background. Gorgeous red sandstone landscapes emerge as we approach **Moab, Utah**. Explore charming downtown Moab this afternoon with its plentiful dining options and myriad of shops. Later, we check into the **Homewood Suites** for two nights. Tonight, we'll enjoy dinner at **Zax Restaurant**.



### **THURSDAY, OCTOBER 15 (BREAKFAST, BOX LUNCH)**

Enjoy breakfast before our fun day of sightseeing begins. Upon our arrival into **Canyonlands National Park**, you'll have the opportunity to walk on the **Mesa Arch Trail**, the shortest and easiest trail in the park. At **Grand View Point** you'll have a great view of magnificent rocks, spires, and mesas that rise up to 7,100 feet. On our way to **Upheaval Dome** we'll turn off at the **Green River Overlook** for the best view in the park! We will visit **Dead Horse Point State Park**, which offers magnificent views of pinnacles, buttes, gorges, and cliffs formed by the Colorado River. Enjoy your box lunch with gorgeous river views at the put-in spot for our **raft trip** on the **Colorado River**. Our adventure will take us from the epic vistas of red sandstone monuments and mesas into magnificent canyons with 320 million years of geologic history. We will return to our hotel late this afternoon for a relaxing evening and more time to explore downtown Moab.



### **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 16 (BREAKFAST, DINNER)**

Following breakfast this morning, we will check out of the hotel and head for **Arches National Park**. You will be amazed at the extraordinary product of erosion in the form of giant arches, windows and pedestals that change color with the sunlight. You will have free time for lunch before we head north to **Green River**. Here, we will explore the **John Wesley Powell River History Museum**. Learn the significance of river history through the cultures and landscapes of the Colorado Plateau. Sit back and admire the views on our picturesque drive to **Capitol Reef National Park**. Marvel at a world of spectacular colored cliffs, hidden arches, massive domes, twisting canyons, limitless sky, and desert rock. Here you'll get a real feel for what our





planet might have looked like millions of years before life appeared, when nothing existed but earth and sky. This evening we will check into the **Capitol Reef Resort** in **Torrey** for one night. Enjoy dinner at **The Pioneer Kitchen** tonight.

### **SATURDAY, OCTOBER 17 (BREAKFAST, DINNER)**

Enjoy breakfast this morning before we check out and begin another day full of unique and magnificent adventures! Our drive takes us south along Utah's **Highway 12 Scenic Byway**, which winds through alpine mountains and colorful rock formations. We'll see the **Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument** before our arrival into Bryce Canyon. After time for lunch, we'll spend the afternoon with a professional guide in **Bryce Canyon National Park**. You will be absolutely awestruck by the indescribable beauty found in this 36,000-acre park. The long series of amphitheaters filled with eroded limestone towers, known as hoodoos, make this one of the most photographed places in America. We'll make stops in the park where you will have time to walk or just sit and soak up this enchanting fairyland of stone. Later this evening, our scenic journey brings us to **Springdale** where we will check in for one night at the **Springhill Suites**. Springdale is the gateway community to Zion National Park and provides spectacular scenic views in every direction. Tonight's dinner is included at a local restaurant.

### **SUNDAY, OCTOBER 18 (BREAKFAST, LUNCH)**

After breakfast, we will enter **Zion National Park**. We'll have time on our own to explore the Visitor Center and some of the park's hiking trails before taking a **narrated tram tour**, which will take us past Zion's sheer rust-colored sandstone cliffs that rise thousands of feet in every direction. Hanging gardens cling to the porous rock and a forest of Cottonwood trees accompany the Virgin River on its carving path through the depths of the canyon. Every turn in the road is a photo stop. Afterward, we'll have lunch in the Zion Lodge and then begin our drive to dazzling **Las Vegas, Nevada**, where we will check into the **Flamingo Hotel** for one night. The evening is free for you to explore the bustling Las Vegas Strip.

### **MONDAY, OCTOBER 19**

This morning we will depart the hotel and head to the Las Vegas airport for our flight home. We'll be taking with us fond memories of the beautiful sites and fun activities we experienced journeying from *Rockies to Red Rocks!*
