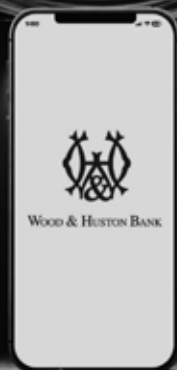

..... **DIRECTOR'S NOTE**

Times are tough for theaters and arts organizations across the country. And art has a funny way of imitating life, doesn't it? As you sit in your seats, waiting for the curtain to rise, the actors backstage are getting into character as The Tried and True Players—a fictional, plucky theater troupe facing a devastating eviction notice because they simply cannot pay the rent. At its heart, tonight's performance celebrates one of the oldest, most beloved stories in stage history: the classic melodrama trope of the evil landlord demanding the rent. For over a century, audiences have cheered as the helpless innocent cries out, and gasped as the villain twirls his mustache, only for a handsome hero to swoop in at the final, breathless second to save the day with a bag of gold. That simple, powerful story about the fight to survive has inspired some of the greatest art ever made. It is the direct ancestor of Giacomo Puccini's tragic opera "La Bohème." Decades later, that exact same plot was reborn on Broadway as the groundbreaking rock musical "Rent."

"The Musical of Musicals (The Musical!)" takes that single, iconic "pay the rent" storyline and reimagines it five distinct times, channeling the voices of musical theater's most prolific writers. You will see our landlord and heroes transformed by the sweeping Americana of Rodgers & Hammerstein, the complex darkness of Stephen Sondheim, the glamorous showmanship of Jerry Herman, the bombastic rock-opera spectacle of Andrew Lloyd Webber, and the gritty Kander & Ebb.

As you watch, we challenge you to look and listen closely. This show is absolutely packed with Easter eggs, musical motifs, and lyrical nods to the history of Broadway. Consider this your official invitation to test your musical theater knowledge and hunt for the hidden references woven into every scene.
