Depart this evening on our overnight flight bound for **Reykjavik, Iceland**.

Wednesday, July 21 (Dinner) **Welcome to Reykjavík**

Welcome to Iceland! Upon arrival in Reykjavík, we'll begin our Icelandic adventure with a sightseeing tour of the country's vibrant capital. Discover the charming city center as we see some of Reykjavík's most notable landmarks, including the striking **Harpa Concert Hall**, an architectural masterpiece shimmering along the waterfront. We'll also visit **Reykjavík Cathedral** and explore the historic **Old Harbour**, once the heart of the city's fishing industry and now a lively area filled with shops, cafés and waterfront views. Along the way, we'll drive past **Höfði House**, a historic landmark best known as the setting for the 1986 Reagan-Gorbachev summit that helped pave the way toward the end of the Cold War.

Following our sightseeing, we'll settle into the **Hotel Reykjavík Grand**, our comfortable home for the evening. Tonight, we'll gather for a delicious dinner at the hotel.

Thursday, July 22 (Breakfast, Dinner) **Iceland's Spectacular South Coast**

Today we leave Reykjavík behind and begin our journey along Iceland's breathtaking southeast coast, where dramatic waterfalls, volcanic landscapes and rugged scenery unfold at every turn. Our first stop is **Almar Bakarí** in Hella, a beloved local bakery where you can get coffee and treat yourself to a tasty pastry.

We continue to **Skógafoss**, one of Iceland's most impressive waterfalls, where enormous volumes of water plunge over a former sea cliff into the river below. From there, we travel to the charming seaside village of **Vík**, where we'll have time to enjoy lunch and browse the local shops. As we continue eastward, the scenery becomes increasingly otherworldly. We'll cross **Eldhraun**, the vast moss-covered lava field created by one of Iceland's most significant volcanic eruptions, before making a stop at the beautiful **Stjórnarfoss**, a picturesque waterfall surrounded by lush green countryside and dramatic mountain scenery.

Late this afternoon, we'll arrive at the **four-star Hotel Jökulsárlón**, beautifully situated in the southeast of Iceland. After settling in, we'll enjoy dinner at the hotel and relax amid the stunning landscapes that make this region of Iceland so unforgettable.

Friday, July 23 (Breakfast, Dinner) **Glaciers, Ice Diamonds & Black Sand Beaches**

Today brings some of Iceland's most spectacular natural wonders. We begin at **Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon**, where enormous icebergs calved from the nearby glacier drift peacefully across the deep blue lagoon. We'll experience this extraordinary landscape from the water on a **boat excursion**, getting an up-close look at the brilliant blues, whites and striking shapes of the floating ice.

Next, we'll visit the nearby **Black Sand Beach**, where fragments of crystal-clear glacial ice wash ashore creating a dramatic contrast against the dark volcanic sand. Known as Iceland's "Ice Diamond Beach," this remarkable place is one of the most unforgettable sights of our journey.

Our adventure continues to **Skaftafell National Park**, part of the vast **Vatnajökull National Park**, where glaciers, rugged mountains, waterfalls and volcanic landscapes come together in spectacular fashion.

On arrival in the village of **Vik**, we will check into our hotel with time to relax, shop, or set off on an *optional Icelandic horseback ride* before we meet for dinner at our hotel.

Saturday, July 24 (Breakfast) Coastal Wonders & Setting Sail from Reykjavík

Our Icelandic adventure continues this morning with a visit to **Dyrhólaey**, a dramatic promontory rising above the southern coast and offering spectacular views of the Atlantic Ocean, rugged cliffs and sweeping black-sand beaches. Keep your eyes open for seabirds as we admire the remarkable natural arch that extends into the sea. We'll also see the striking **Three Sisters** and marvel at the fascinating **basalt columns**, formed by ancient volcanic activity and shaped over time by the forces of nature.

Next, we'll visit **Seljalandsfoss**, one of Iceland's most famous and photogenic waterfalls. Cascading from a former sea cliff, this beautiful waterfall is especially memorable because a path leads behind the falling water, offering a truly unique perspective.

Later today, we return to Reykjavík and make our way to the pier to board the **Celebrity Silhouette** for our luxurious **seven-night Iceland cruise**. Settle into your stateroom, explore the ship and take in the excitement as we sail away from Iceland's shores. Tonight, enjoy your first dinner onboard and relax as the next chapter of our Icelandic journey begins. **(Beginning with lunch today, all meals will be served on the ship.)**

Seydisfjörður is an eclectic little town, tucked away at the end of a deep fjord in the east of Iceland. Surrounded by volcanoes, waterfalls, and green summer fields dotted with purple lupins, this former hub for herring fishing is a favorite stop on cruises to Iceland. Walk alongside colorful wooden homes and the famous rainbow-painted street leading to the pretty blue church as you enjoy the fresh, crisp air. Immerse yourself in Icelandic art and culture, and celebrate Seydisfjörður's rich history as a creative community. Venture through incredible natural surroundings as you trek to the cascading Gufufoss waterfalls, and wander along the shore looking out for seals and porpoises before continuing on your Iceland cruise.

Tuesday, July 27

ARRIVE 8:00 AM

Today is a spectacular day of exploration as we set out on an **included private shore excursion from Akureyri** into the wild and beautiful landscapes of northern Iceland. Our journey takes us to the charming fishing village of **Húsavík**, often considered one of Iceland's premier whale-watching destinations. From here, we'll board a whale-watching cruise and venture into Skjálfandi Bay, keeping watch for magnificent whales and other marine life as we sail through these northern waters. We'll be traveling close to the Arctic Circle, adding a memorable sense of adventure to our day.

After our cruise, we'll continue our scenic journey through the rugged countryside, enjoying a **box lunch** along the way. Our destination is **Dettifoss**, one of Europe's most powerful waterfalls, where enormous volumes of glacial water thunder through the dramatic volcanic landscape. We'll also visit **Goðafoss**, the beautiful "Waterfall of the Gods," whose cascading turquoise waters are steeped in Icelandic history and legend.

Filled with unforgettable sights and experiences, we'll return to Akureyri and our ship, where you can relax and reflect on a remarkable day discovering the natural wonders of northern Iceland.

Optional shore excursions are designed to further enhance your time in port. These are offered at an additional cost to guests.

Wednesday, July 28

The largest town in the Westfjords peninsula, **Isafjörður** is known for its breathtaking landscapes. Enjoy a wide variety of outdoor activities including hiking, kayaking, horseback riding and whale watching, or explore the history of the town. It started as a trading post in the 16th century with growth triggered in the 19th century by salt fish production, which is still the most important industry for the town.

Thursday, July 29

AT SEA

Today is yours to explore all the ship has to offer. Taste the delicacies of a signature restaurant or spoil yourself with a visit to the spa.

Friday, July 30

ARRIVE 7:00 AM

Today we set out on an **included private shore excursion** to explore Iceland's famous **Golden Circle**, beginning with the spectacular **Kerið Crater**. This striking volcanic crater is filled with a beautiful blue-green lake and surrounded by vivid red and green volcanic rock, creating a scene that is as colorful as it is unusual.

Next, we'll visit magnificent **Gullfoss**, the "Golden Waterfall," where the Hvítá River plunges dramatically down a two-tiered canyon. We continue to the famous **Geysir geothermal area**, where steaming vents, bubbling pools and the active **Strokkur geyser** create an unforgettable display of Iceland's powerful geothermal activity.

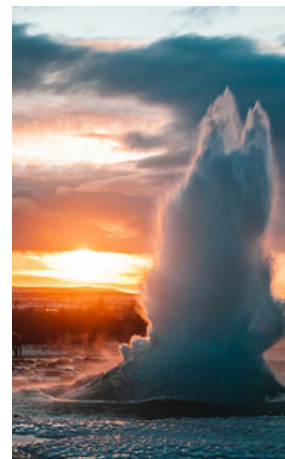
Our journey then takes us to **Friðheimar**, a unique family-run hydroponic tomato farm where geothermal energy makes it possible to grow tomatoes year-round. We'll enjoy a delicious lunch surrounded by the warmth and greenery of the greenhouse, followed by an entertaining **Icelandic horse show** featuring the country's beloved and distinctive horses.

Our final stop is **Pingvellir National Park**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site rich in both geological and historical significance. Here, we'll experience the dramatic landscape where the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates meet and learn about the historic site where Iceland's parliament was established more than a thousand years ago.

After a wonderful day filled with waterfalls, geothermal wonders, delicious flavors and Icelandic traditions, we'll return to our ship with unforgettable memories of Iceland's Golden Circle.

Saturday, July 31 (Breakfast)

This morning we'll disembark the ship in **Reykjavik, Iceland**. Bid farewell to Iceland as we make our way to the airport for our flight home. We'll take with us cherished memories of *Incredible Iceland, the land of fire and ice!*
